

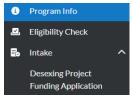
SPCA Desexing Grant Application Guide

When you first arrive on the SPCA Desexing Grant website you'll see the Program Info page which provides an overview of the Grant, including application requirements.



The menu on left hand side of the page allows you to navigate between the pages on the website.



Optional: Can you preview the full application before starting. To do this, select "Desexing Project Funding Application" from the menu and then click "View" on each section of the application. You can also click "Download Preview" if you prefer.

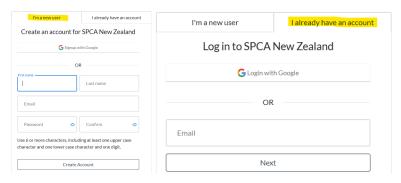


Once you're ready to start the application process click "Apply". Alternatively, you can click "Log In" at the top of the screen then click "Sign Up".



Regardless of which option you click (apply or log in) you will be taken to the same screen.

If this is your first time applying for an SPCA Desexing Grant through this website, you'll need to create an account as a "new user". If you're a returning applicant (2026 onwards), you'll select "I already have an account" and log in.





Once you have created a new account, you will be prompted to enter a code to verify your email address. The code will be sent to the email address you used when creating your account.

Please check your junk/spam folder for the verification email if you don't see it appear in your inbox within a few minutes. The email will look like this:



If you're a returning applicant or this isn't your first time logging into the website, you won't be asked to verify your email. Once you've entered the code or logged in, you will return to the main page of the website. Click "Apply" to start.



If this is your first time applying for an SPCA Desexing Grant through this website, you will need to create an organisation profile before you start the application process. The website will prompt you to do this. Click "Create New Organisation" to continue.

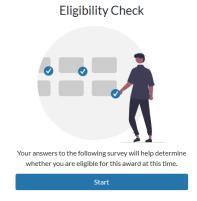
If you're a returning applicant (2026 onwards) or not logging in for the first time you will not need to complete the above step. Simply select your organisation name to continue.

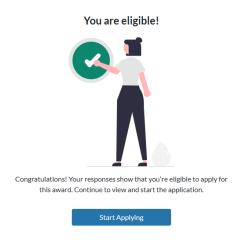
All applicants will then be prompted to complete an eligibility check. This must be completed before applying for each funding round. Click "Start" to continue.



Answer the eligibility question(s) and click "Check Eligibility" at the bottom of the screen.



If you're an eligible applicant, you'll then be prompted to start the application process. Click "Start Applying" to continue.





The application is set out in nine sections. You can complete the application in any order, but all required fields must be completed before submitting. Click "Start" to begin.



You can click "Next" at the bottom of the page to be taken to the next section.



At any time, you can click "Save Draft & Exit Section" at the bottom of the page.

Save Draft & Exit Section

This will take you back to the application section page.

If a section has a red marker next to it, you still need to complete this part of the application. In the example below, the applicant has finished their Organisation Information but hasn't completed Projection Description and Details or Animal Numbers.



If you are not a registered charity or incorporated society, you will be prompted to request a Letter of Support from a veterinary clinic and a registered charity e.g. another rescue you've worked with. This a mandatory field and is completed through the online system as part of the application process. You will need to enter a valid email address for both support letters which will trigger an automatic email to be sent to them. The email they received will look similar to this:



When they have completed the request, which includes uploading their Letter of Support, you will receive an email notification advising you that this has been completed. Note: You will not be able to submit your application until these are completed. We recommend that you advise them in advance that they will be receiving a request.



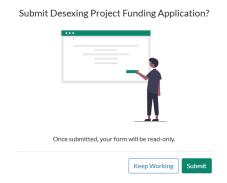
Once you have completed the required fields across all sections, you will be able to submit your application. You can either click "Submit" at the top of the page or click "Review" before submitting.



If you click "Review" you will see all sections at once and be given the option to edit before submitting at the bottom of the page.

Section 1: Organisation Information Edit

Clicking "Submit" through either option will provide you with once last opportunity to "Keep Working" on your application or "Submit".



Once you've submitted, click "Go to Your Applications" on the pop-up.



You will now see that your application status is "Submitted". You can review your application from here, but you cannot edit it. Click "View" on the right of the page to see your application.



From the menu on the left of the page, you can view your profile and edit it if needed.



Note: You will be notified of any updates on your application via email and be prompted to log in to your profile on the website to view details of these updates e.g. more application information required, successful award status, approval letters etc.
